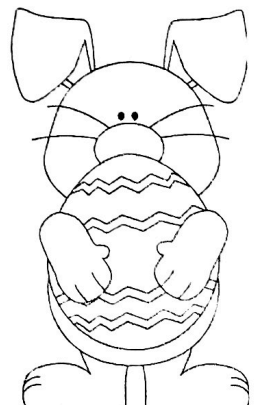
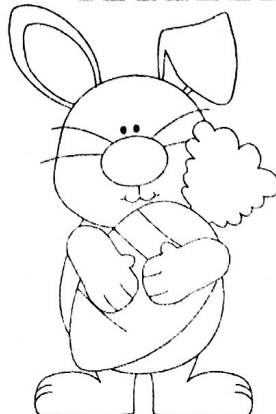
EASTER EGG HUNT
