## **Flowers**

If you place flowers at the cemetery for Memorial Day, please remove them before **Monday June 3<sup>rd</sup>**.

For several years Elsinore Town has had a Weed Spraying Program. The Town has sprayed all areas of town with a concentration on problem areas and puncture vines, sometimes referred to as "goat heads".

As will all things in the current economy, the cost of weed spray has increased dramatically. This money could be put to a better use if property and homeowners would maintain the frontage of their land from the property line to the pavement.

This includes not dumping limbs, appliances, vehicles, rocks, debris, noxious weeds or other unsightly nuisances posing threats on frontage property, Town or private. (Section 25 Land Use)

**Elsinore Town will be spraying less this year, and we are asking citizens to care for their property and frontage.**

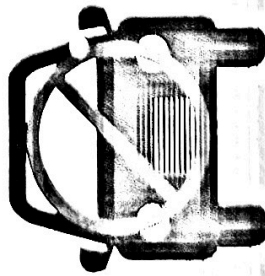

## Shield Your Field

Divert rain and surface water away and avoid parking vehicles and planting trees on your drainfield.



## Don't Overload the Commode

Don't flush diapers, wipes or other items meant for a trashcan down the toilet.

## Think at the Sink

Limit use of your garbage disposal and avoid pouring fats, grease, solids and harsh chemicals down the drain.

## Don't Strain Your Drain

Use water efficiently and stagger use of water-based appliances, such as your washing machine or dishwasher.

## Pump Your Tank

Ensure your septic tank is pumped at regular intervals as recommended by a professional.

## Protect It and Inspect It

A typical septic system should be serviced every one to three years by a septic service professional.

## Keep It Clean

If you are on a well, test your drinking water regularly to ensure it remains clean and free of contamination.
