-Dogs are not allowed loose and must be on a leash. Please clean up after your pets!!

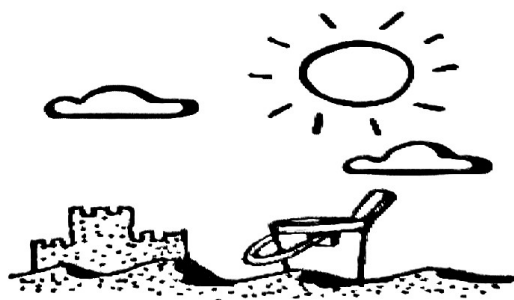
-Park still has a curfew and is closed at dark.

All ordinances, water reports & budget reports are available for viewing anytime at the town office.

If you use the **irrigation ditches** you are in charge of preventing flooding and erosion, cleaning up debris, taking your water at the correct time, informing other users of turning water on/off and making sure any run-off water can get back to a canal without causing damage.

Fireworks

Per Resolution 5-1-2024, fireworks will be allowed in Elsinore Town in 2025.

Just a reminder, “Users of fireworks, be it ground or aerial, will be held liable for any fires, damages, or injuries to people, pets, or livestock, structures, or property, be it on private or public lands. All damages will be paid for by said user.”

You may discharge Class C common State approved fireworks.

Discharge

Between the hours of 11:00am & 11:00pm except as noted:

**July 2 – July 5
(July 4 hours extended to midnight)**

**July 22 – July 25
(July 24 hours extended to midnight)**

December 31, 11:00am – January 1, 11:00pm

Safety tips from the National Council on Fireworks Safety

- Use fireworks outdoors only.
- Obey local laws. If fireworks are not legal where you live, do not use them.
 - Always have water handy.
- Only use fireworks as intended. DO NOT try to alter them or combine them.
 - Never re-light a “dud” firework.
- Use common sense when using fireworks.
 - Alcohol and fireworks do not mix.
- Only persons over age 12 should be allowed to handle sparklers of any type.
- DO NOT ever use homemade fireworks or illegal explosives: they can kill!
Report illegal explosives to the fire or police department in your community.
